All event group's objectives are guided by the overarching statement of 'Australia versus the Rest of the World', the fundamental purpose of the panels is to:

- Bring together event group coaches/experts to discuss ways to enhance the "Spirit of the Event Group".
- Establish a Three-Year Event Group Plan which will include items such as a calendar of camps/workshops/initiatives aimed at upskilling emerging and established coaches and enhancing the overarching "Spirit of the Event Group"; and
- Identify and implement initiatives that will enhance Australia's capability to achieve sustainable success
 (i.e. by achieving Medals and Top 8 performances) at Major Championships by the 2032 Brisbane OGs
 and beyond.

The Throws Event Group Panel's plan, aims to achieve these objectives by:

- Event group training camps:
 - Annual State Based Throws Festival's aimed at 15–18-year-old athletes
 - Focus on development of athletes and coaches
 - Improve connection and collegiality within and between states.
 - o Annual High Performance training camp aimed at U20 + Open athletes.
 - Centralised camps and further satellite, bespoke camps on a needs or opportunity basis
 - State based clinics
 - In conjunction with State based TTP activities and AA domestic tour meets
- Coach Development opportunities
 - o A Coaches Conference built around the HP Camp
 - State based clinics
 - o Targeted, individualised experiential learning
 - Team coach roles for developing coaches
 - Mentors
- Paralympic program
 - Coach education on Para specific topics e.g. Seated Throws, impairments, opportunities
 - Integrated training environments
 - Widen the talent pool by working with other sports e.g. Wheelchair rugby, powerlifting etc.
- International Competition Opportunity
 - o An annual international experience for U23 athletes
- Australian competition opportunities
 - Open dialogue with AA and State associations to ensure throwers are adequately catered for at State and National level.
 - o Develop and support "Throwers Club" meets in each state.

The Throws Event Group performance indicators:

- 1. Throws results depth and quality at the Australian All Schools and/or the National Underage Championships from 2025 onwards.
- 2. Full team of Throwers qualify for each World Under 20 Championship from 2026 onward, World University Games from 2027 onwards, World Championships & Olympic Games from 2032 onwards.
- 3. Increased representation and medallists at the Paralympics and Para-World Championships.
- 4. Improved capability of existing coaches.
- 5. Increased number of coaches, in particular female coaches.
- 6. Improved representation and showcasing of the throws events at National level meets.

Event group recommendations (note this is an advisory group)

- 1. Where possible provide input/consultation into the event grid for major domestic competitions.
- 2. Have a flow chart of those that are responsible in AA/NINs for providing and support to categorised athletes.
