As in 2025, Para Field Athletes will be paid prizemoney, should the performance place them in the top 5 placings of the event and where their percentage score is equal or greater than the equivalent able-bodied placed athletes' percentage, of the able bodied world record.

Total prizemoney available AUD\$25,000 and in the case of events that have an 'A' and 'B Race' is awarded to athletes in 'A Races' only.

Australian Athletics will contact prize money winners via email. No money will be paid on event day.

Prize money will be provided in Australian Dollars (AUD) for the 2026 Hobart Track Classic.

Athletes are required to be current financial members of their own AA Member Association and/or World Athletics Member Federation. Any athlete who does not meet this requirement on the day of the competition will not be entitled to any prize money and may forfeit acknowledgement of their performance including any ranking and/or placing points.

**Please note Australian Athletics must wait until clearance of the doping control tests before paying any prize money for the event.**
