VAULTING POLE LEASE AGREEMENT

This agreement is between:

Australian Athletics (AA) ("the Lessor")

and

The person or organisation identified below ("the Lessee").

AA agrees to lease the vaulting pole(s) identified in this agreement to the Lessee, subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. Lease Fee and Payment

1. The lease fee is **\$60 per month**, payable in advance.
 2. AA will issue invoices to the Lessee for the lease fees.
 3. The Lessee is responsible for ensuring that all lease payments are made by the due date.
 4. If payments are not made when due, AA may suspend or terminate the lease and require the immediate return of the poles.
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2. Transport and Storage

1. The Lessee is responsible for all costs associated with transporting the poles.
 2. The poles are ordinarily stored in Melbourne.
 3. When not in use, the poles must be stored in a manner that minimises the risk of damage.
 4. Poles must not be left lying on the ground. They should be stored in a suitable pole tube, rack or other appropriate elevated storage system.
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3. Damage, Breakage or Loss

1. The Lessee accepts responsibility for the care and safekeeping of the leased poles for the duration of the lease.
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2. If a leased pole is broken, lost, stolen or damaged beyond further safe use, the Lessee will be responsible for paying AA the depreciated value of the pole.
3. The depreciated value will be determined according to the depreciation schedule included in this agreement.
4. Normal wear and tear associated with appropriate use of the poles will not be considered damage.
5. The Lessee must notify AA as soon as reasonably possible if a pole is damaged, broken, lost or stolen.

4. Return of Poles

At the conclusion or termination of the lease, all poles must be returned to AA within the timeframe requested by AA.

The poles must be returned:

- free from athletic tape, markings or stickers applied by the Lessee or any user;
- cleaned of chalk, grip spray, resin or any other substances; and
- in reasonable condition, allowing for normal wear and tear.

The Lessee is responsible for the cost of transporting the poles back to the location nominated by AA unless otherwise agreed.

5. Use of the Poles

1. The poles may only be used for pole vault training and competition purposes.
2. The Lessee must ensure that the poles are only used by appropriately supervised vaulters.
3. The Lessee may permit other athletes to use the poles but remains fully responsible for the poles and for ensuring compliance with this agreement.
4. The Lessee must not sell, sublease, or otherwise transfer possession of the poles to another person or organisation without the prior approval of AA.
5. The Lessee must not modify or alter the poles in any way.

6. Safety and Care of the Poles



The Lessee is responsible for ensuring that all users of the leased poles comply with the following requirements:

1. Vaulting poles must be inspected for signs of damage before every use.
2. A pole must never be used if it shows any signs of damage or deterioration.
3. Users must respect the maximum weight rating of each pole.
4. A vaulter must never use a pole with a manufacturer's indicated weight rating, in either kilograms or pounds, below the vaulter's body weight.
5. Reasonable care must be taken at all times to prevent poles from striking the runway, standards or other hard surfaces.
6. A qualified coach must be present when the poles are being used.
7. The poles must only be used in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations and applicable athletics safety requirements.

7. Termination of the Lease

1. **Either party** may terminate the lease by providing reasonable written notice to the other party.
2. AA may terminate the lease immediately if:
 - the Lessee fails to make required payments;
 - the poles are not properly cared for or are used in an unsafe manner;
 - the Lessee breaches any condition of this agreement; or
 - AA reasonably requires the poles to be returned for another purpose.
3. Upon termination of the lease, the Lessee must return all leased poles in accordance with Section 4 of this agreement.

8. General Conditions

1. The poles remain the property of Australian Athletics at all times.
 2. Nothing in this agreement transfers ownership of the poles to the Lessee.
 3. The Lessee must not remove, alter or obscure any identifying labels or markings applied by AA or the manufacturer.
 4. Any variation to this agreement must be agreed to in writing by AA.
 5. AA reserves the right to inspect the condition and storage of the leased poles upon reasonable notice.
